- 2.1. Grants and Funding
- 2.1.1 Blue Jays Care Foundation

We received funding for Challenger Baseball for our Blendations team. Foundations and

Blended students will participate in developmentally appropriate baseball activities. This will occur once weekly in the Gym.

Blue Jays Care has provided us with a variety of baseball equipment. St. Joseph's Ball

Academy will also be joining us for this.

2.1.2 ParticipACTION

We applied for a grant and received \$1000 for inclusive PE materials for our Blendations classes.

We have a prester on April 26 coming to give us some PD at which point our team will be ordering some new PE equipment for our students.

2.1.3 We will be partnering with the YMCA to have some after school programming at our school. The

YMCA will be coming once a week after school for an hour and a half to support students in

positive social and sport related activities. We are excited about this partnership, which is an innovative and first pilot project being undertaken by the YMCA. More details about this project will be forthcoming
